College Portfolio Deans (Multiple positions)

- Transformational roles in a newly created structure

As part of the University Strategic Plan and Future Horizon 2017-2027, Murdoch University has created two new Colleges - College of Science, Health, Engineering and Education (SHEE) and College of Arts, Business, Law and Social Sciences (ABLSS). These positions will work together in realigning our academic structure towards greater collaboration and innovative multidisciplinary approaches in teaching, learning and research programs; they will provide new opportunities to students for a broader range of interdisciplinary study options.

The Positions

Reporting to the newly appointed Pro Vice Chancellors (PVCs), the Portfolio Deans are members of the College Executive and are leadership roles designed to support the PVC to drive strategy and align their respective College with the University's Strategic Plan.

Dean Academic Operations

The Dean Academic Operations (Deputy to the PVC) oversees the academic portfolio, including accreditation and quality standards, academic staff workload and performance processes. The Heads of Disciplines within the College report into this Dean. This role will also work closely with the Provost.

Dean Engagement

The Dean Engagement represents a key role in extending and leveraging external engagement with business, government and not-for-profit organisations. This role will be nationally and internationally focussed and will connect external bodies and key individuals, developing partnerships and relationships to further enhance both our research and course portfolios. It will work very strongly with the Dean Engagement of the second College in developing relationships externally.

Dean International

The Dean International plays a vital part in developing and implementing the College International strategy in alignment with the University's International Plan 2018-2023. Murdoch is growing its international student population and this will be a key first focus of the Dean. The role will assist in identifying new income streams from international sources for the College in conjunction with the Deputy Vice Chancellor International.

Dean Learning and Teaching

The Dean Learning and Teaching is responsible for enhancing learning and teaching quality, learner support technology enhanced learning, curriculum design, and academic development in learning and teaching within the College. This role will also work with the PVC Education.

Dean Research

The Dean Research works closely with the PVC and DVC Research & Innovation to identify and implement College-specific research objectives, which directly contribute to achieving the goals of the Murdoch University Research and Innovation Plan 2018-2023. This will include support for HDR students. The position will work closely with the leaders of the research institutes at Murdoch.
