4.1	ACDHS Council meeting 28 July 2022
	Executive considered the draft Council agenda noting the proposed presentation by the Professors of Allied Health group.
	It was resolved:
	That the Professors of Allied Health (PAH) be invited to meet with Council specifically on:
	1. Articulating to Council PHA purpose and objectives.



- 2. A brief overview of the landscape, ie number of appointments.
- 3. How the PHA see themselves working with and contributing to ACDHS.
- 4. Understanding how conjoint appointments are established and how universities can best navigate the process.
- 5. Hearing Council members' experiences of such appointments.
- 6. PHA perspectives/examples of the contribution such appointments make to both the university and the health service.

5. Matters for Discussion

5.1 Secretariat operations 2023

Executive were advised that the current Executive Officer will conclude her contract with ACDHS on 6 January 2023 (to effectively co-incide with the commencement of ACDHS Ltd). Discussion ensued about models of operation of the new entity, the role and function of a new National Director and the management of administration.

It was resolved that further information be provided to Executive specifically:

- Proposals be sought from secretariat support service providers for the provision of payroll, book-keeping and website maintenance.
- 2. Examples of senior 'executive officer' position descriptions be obtained to inform the recruitment of a new National Director.

5.2 Council meeting – F2F October

The Council meeting scheduled for 20 October 2022 will be held as a face-face in Sydney ahead of the Symposium on 21 October. Ideas were canvassed as to presentation/discussion component of the agenda.

It was resolved that:

- 1. Council members be surveyed as to their preferences based on the following list of topics:
 - Compliance and readiness for placement in the new COVID world: issues and strategies.
 - A large health service provider's experience of delivering clinical education in an (ongoing) pandemic: lessons learnt.
 - Commercialisation of allied health research.
 - University health precincts: drivers of innovation in healthcare research, education and delivery.
 - Allied health Life as a Clinician Scientist



2. Ian Wronski be invited to present on the ACDHS Journey: a retrospective in celebration of its evolution, achievements and to herald ACDHS Ltd.

5.3 Building the Case for a Coordinated Approach to the National Health and Care Workforce Strategy

Executive considered the feasibility of an ACDHS led project advocating for a nationally coordinated health workforce planning agency to bring together nursing, medical and allied health workforce strategy, specifically:

- Given health workforce is broader than allied health, how appropriate is it for ACDHS to lead?
- To be effective would require support from Medical Deans, Nursing and health service providers. What would be the appetite for MDANZ and Council of Deans of Nursing to collaborate?
- With reference to the above, is this better driven by Universities Australia through HPESG?
- Is this an issue better progressed through the new ACDHS Ltd Strategic Plan (2023).

It was resolved that advice be sought from the UA Policy Director: Health and Workforce and for further consideration by Executive.
